- SDMA released **Rs. 3.00 million (2.00 + 1.00)** to Deputy Commissioner Mirpur/Chairman DDMA to meet urgent/emergency needs of affectees.
- Fleet of trucks held with SDMA deployed at Mirpur for disbursement of relief items among affectees.
- Compensation package of 1.00 million (0.5 million each by Govt. of AJ&K and Federal Govt.) have been paid to the heirs of deceased persons.
- 50 Ton-Truck Mounted Crane has deployed/deputed in Mirpur for recovery operation.

Rescue

- Immediate rescue operation launched.
- Teams of rescue 1122 from Bhimber, Kotli and Mirpur along with Army, Civil Defence and Rescue Team of 1122 Jehlum and Kharian (Punjab) carried out search and rescue operation and provide emergency First Aid to the victims.
- Emergency declared in all hospitals of Mirpur & Bhimber.
- Team of SDMA lead by Deputy Director State Disaster Management Authority reached Mirpur for coordination rescue operation.
- Coordination with District Administration, NDMA, and other relevant department to assess the loss of lives and infrastructure.
- NDMA has established Woman & Child Protection Center at village Sangkikri District Mirpur to provide psychosocial support to the affected woman and children.

Relief

- A cabinet committee formulated under the Chairmanship of Minister Relief, Disaster Management & Civil Defence to monitor and oversee the overall rescue, relief and rehabilitation activities, carried out in the affected areas.
- Camp office of SDMA established to coordinate all the relief activities/operations. Necessary/logistics staff of SDMA has deployed in camp office.
- Control Rooms are activated in Earthquake affected districts.
- The Honorable Prime Minister GoAJ&K, Minister Relief Disaster Management & Civil Defence, Chief Secretary, Additional Chief Secretary (Gen), Additional Chief Secretary (Dev), Senior Member Board of Revenue and Secretaries to the Government including Secretary, Relief Disaster Management & Civil Defence are constantly monitoring onsite Relief and Recovery operation
- The Honorable Prime Minister, Islamic Republic of Pakistan visited that affected area and expressed sympathy to the injured in hospitals.
- The Chairman, Pakistan People's Party visited the area and was briefed by the Minister Relief Disaster Management & Civil Defence about the damages and ongoing activities of rescue, relief, recovery and rehabilitation activities carried by Govt. of AJ&K.
- Director General PDMA KPK and official of PDMA Punjab visited the affected areas and assisted in relief goods.
- Chairman NDMA along with his team visited the affected areas and provided necessary humanitarian relief.
